Board Member Reports

President: Tuesday, July 9 - Di: The District will be writing a check for \$1600 to each team that went to regionals in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Larry is in contact with Tom Parker re: use of the Good Sheperd fields for Class I practices. If these fields become available it will relieve the demand on other sites.

3 teams from Santa Cruz County made the Premier League. Practice for these teams will be on our fields. Games will be played in Morgan Hill.

Hardship Reimbursement: So far, our County's requests from Class I and Pajaro teams (which have applied) total about \$4,000. District only has about \$7000 budgeted for teams throughout the District. Larry is in touch with Paul Gallegos from Santa Cruz County re: possibility of more financial aid. The District needs better system to allocate funds. Clubs should apply to the League regardless of limit. League will distribute based on need shown.

Larry attended the DII Cup meeting. Paul Vargas is the Tournament Director. Our League hosts the weekend of Nov. 23 and 24 for the U11 Boys at Morgan Hill. We are responsible for Fields, facilities 2. Referees 3. Communication with teams 4. Score Boards and scoring 5. Field Marshalls 6. Awards Presentation 7. Water and food for referees. 8. Directions to fields on Webmaster 9. Appoint Director to handle all matters 10. Report results to DII Commissioner. Refs report each game and include name of referees.
