Meeting Called to order : 7:02pm -

- I. Introductions – Several people from Scotts Valley attending
  - A. Marcus – would like to see under 12 local tournament – to include d4 players in this tournament. This could be like a county cup. Generally the board seems to think that it is a good idea. The idea is to make it small and try to limit it to a single day tournament. Winner could represent the league at the founders’ cup. Marcus to make a proposal.

- IV. Calendar Business
  - A. New Business
    1. Coach Licensing – the cysa license person is/has been unreachable. Probably an “E” and “F” just after school gets out. Because we couldn’t get it done we are looking to extend the license requirement until the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.     4. PCA Status of clubs – Shawn will drive – Clubs would like to coordinate with coaches meeting. We should still have one more freebee this year from CYSA. SC – recommends that we do mentor coaching again this year.
    5. Number of Division 3 teams –We have over 70 teams from the county. How come we only have 2 teams from our county going to the Association Cup? Is this even a league level issue? No change this year.
    6. Requirement of each club to send one team to Association Cup, or alternately State Cup or Division 4 State Cup, or pay usage surcharge to the league. This would be a nice to have
